#### **Notes for teachers**

The pupils could complete this work after completing the comprehension 'Running for his life'. Ask the children to read the passage carefully, ensuring that they understand that it is a non-fiction information text. For the first three questions, ensure that they consider the words in the context of the passage. Do they remember to write in complete sentences, using appropriate punctuation, for the final three questions? Talk about question 6, encouraging the children to think about what dogs eat, the sounds they make and their appearance.
